Obituary from "The Tasmanian Mail", for 06, Jan. 1906:(Photograph of WTB also available)

"The late Mr. Bates was a native of Hull, Yorkshire, England, and came to Australia some 23 years ago. He then spent about three years in Melbourne, and was leading cornet player in the Royal & Princess theatres. He came to Tasmania to lead the Rechabite Band, and was afterwards conductor of the Garrison Band for many years. He also conducted the Hobart City, Richmond, Bellerive, Kempton, Bismark, Sorell and Filibuster bands at different times, and formed several of them. For a long time he was Grand Trumpeter of the Masonic Lodge.

At the time of his death the deceased was conductor of the City Band, but had been absent on leave for some time, Mr. Clay (his first pupil in Australia) acting in his stead. The late Mr. Bates acted as a judge at the competitions in Sydney, Melbourne, Launceston and Queenstown. The deceased was a connection of the late Poet Laureate, his mother being a member of the Tennyson family, Lincolnshire (See note below). He leaves a widow and six children (one son and five daughters).

Obituary for "The Mercury", Tasmania, for 19 Dec. 1905:

Walter Tennyson Bates answered the "Last Call" on the evening of 18th inst., after a somewhat long illness, having expired at his late residence on Lansdowne Crescent. He had been ailing for some months, and recently took a visit to England and Melbourne in search of a cure, but without avail. The deceased, who was in the 52 year of his age, came from the old country about 20 years ago, and settled in Hobart. Prior to leaving England he was the conductor of the Winter Gardens Band in Southport-one of the best combinations of instrumentalists in England. In Tasmania he had at various time been leader of both the Garrison and City Bands. He was for a long period acknowledged as one of the premier cornet soloists of Australasia. He had of late years conducted a flourishing produce business and had almost given up the idea of taking up the baton again, but when the City Band solicited him he went heart and soul into the work and make that band what it is today. Mr. Bates was highly respected by all who knew him as straightforward businessman. Much sympathy is felt for his wife and family. His funeral will be attended by the bandsmen of the city, and appropriate music will be played en route and at the grave."

Note @08 Nov. 2000: The librarians @ Southport Library have searched the following document: Southport street directories, Southport census index, the library's biography index, the Winter Gardens programmes dating back to the 1880's and the Southport newspapers from the 1870's-1880's. Regretfully, not one single reference to WTB has been found. The Winter Gardens opened in 1874. The original conductor was a Mr. A. Gwllym Crowe, who appears to have been succeeded by a Mr. E. A. Bartle in 1878, and who was still in post in 1885. Perhaps WTB conducted the orchestra on an occasional basis but this principal role was a cornet player.

Note: Tennyson connection: So far, we have oral statements (via Cecil Arthur) from Florence Alberta that the Tennyson connection exists. The obituary form the "Tasmanian Mail" also makes the connection. This is perhaps most likely to have been passed on to WTB by his mother, Mary Tennyson Bates, nee Williams(born in Grimsby, Lincs, 1817). It is noteworthy that all Mary Tennyson 5 siblings (male and female) also carried the 2nd name Tennyson. However, Alfred Lord Tennyson, the Victorian Poet Laureate was born in at Somersby, Lincs in 1809, so he would hardly have been at the height of his fame in 1817, causing relatives to be named after him! So where is the Tennyson connection? The parents of Mary Tennyson were Elizabeth Harrison and John Williams (IGI).

The extracts from "Miscellanea Genealogica et Heraldica" (kindly provided by Peter Newlove) show several Tenn(i)son

families in Holderness and elsewhere, but none in Lincolnshire. Where is the connection, does it truly exist? No mention of Lord Tennyson is make in these extracts but is it a curious coincidence only that the particular researches were carried out by a C. M. Tennyson, Esq. of Hobart, Tasmania (see footnote, P 141)? This aspect to be pursued later this year.

May 21, 1999:

Info: from Laurie Hoffman: WTB sent a postcard from Niagara Falls, New York, on Oct. 2, 1903. How did this come about? Were they, in fact, on the way back to Tasmania, after visited England in a vain attempt to find a remedy for WTB's illness? Laurie also has a book called "Home Influence" by Grace Aguilar. This was given to Elizabeth Jane by WTB on their 19th wedding anniversary (April 22, 1898). There is a touching not inside which reads:

Hobart Tasmania, 22 April 1898

"To my dear wife on the anniversary of our wedding day nineteen years ago, wishing we may be spared to each other for many years.

Sadly, this was not to be the case, as WTB died in Hobart on Dec. 18, 1905. Walter Lawrence Bates, his son must have been about 20 years on this date. His will was dated 28 March 1903. Could it be that he knew he was ill and that the will was prepared before he left for England, in case he died while he was away.

We know that he was at Niagara Falls in Oct. 1903.

I thought she married as they had adopted son named "Athol" (no last name), but on Gertie's gravestone is written "Also Gertrude Bates". Mother (Rita) corresponded with Athol until he wanted to borrow money from her to come to the US after his mother died, so she stopped writing. She said it was given to her by her brother, Walter, as no-one in the family was interested in it. She sent it to me (DMS-where is it now?). I will enclose a few for you to keep. One clipping had a note written beside it "Father's Band"...they had band contests & taught, too.

"Doris Jane (Tennyson) Bates" - Born 29 Oct 1895. I don't recall a married name, but saw here daughter & son (both darling redheads). I think she put them in an orphanage. My mother (Rita) saw the children after they married and had children. Maybe Sylvia saw them too. I remember going to Santa Barbara to see Aunt Doris much later. Her 2nd husband was Mexican (don't recall name) & she had 2 of the cutest little girls. That's all I have on her. My mother (Rita) you know all about."
